## Johnson County Middle/High Dress Code

#### PANTS, SLACKS and JEANS

- 1. Must be worn at the waist and appropriate size.
- 2. Should come to the top of the shoes and not the floor
- 3. Neither baggy pants nor wide legged (elephant legged) pants are permissible
- 4. Underwear/shorts underneath pants, slacks, and jeans should not be visible.
- 5. Belts must be worn with all pants with belt loops.
- 6. Holes and Frays in clothing must not show any skin.
- 7. No athletic shorts or jogging pants
- 8. Leggings and tights must be worn with a knee-length, loose fitting shirt/top.

#### SHIRTS or BLOUSES

- 1. Shirts or blouses cannot be more than 6 inches below the waist line
- 2. No vulgarity, profanity, tobacco-related, alcohol-related, drug-related, gang-related, or sexual messages or images.
- 3. No tank tops, spaghetti strings, halter tops, tube tops, nor mesh type shirts. Sleeveless blouses are allowed but not in tank top like sleeves—top of shoulder must be covered.
- 4. No bare midriff.
- 5. Under garments should not be visible
- 6. Must be decent, non-suggestive, and non-distractive

#### SWEATERS/SWEATSHIRTS/JACKETS

- 1. No see-through sweaters unless worn over a shirt or blouse
- 2. No vulgarity, profanity, tobacco-related, alcohol-related, drug-related, gang-related, offensive or sexual messages or images on shirts, sweaters, sweatshirts, jackets, etc.

#### SKIRTS, DRESSES, CULOTTES, and JUMPERS

- 1. Must be decent, not-suggestive, and non-distractive, no cleavage
- 2. No longer than the top of the shoes
- 3. Jumper must be worn with shirts or blouses underneath
- 4. No shorter than knee length in the front and back

#### SHORTS

1. Must be knee length

#### **ACCESSORIES**

1. No caps, hats, bandanas, head stockings, headbands, scarves allowed in the building (no bandanas on campus at any time)

- 2. A student should not wear *ANYTHING* on his/her head in the building unless a doctor prescribes it.
  - a. No hoodies in the building.
  - b. No sunglasses (except prescription with doctor note)-not around head or neck
  - c. No piercing except on the ears
  - d. No trench coats
  - e. No spiked jewelry, spiked belts, nor studded belt buckles
  - f. No tongue rings or "Grillz"(gold or silver removable caps on the front teeth or nose rings)
  - g. No vulgarity, profanity, tobacco-related, drug related, gang-related, or sexual messages or images on jewelry.

#### **SHOES**

- 1. No bedroom shoes
- 2. Shoes must be worn at all times

### HAIR

- 1. Hair must be well groomed
- 2. Hair rollers or pin curlers will not be allowed

\*\*Clothing/Attire and accessories which interfere with the instruction of other students will not be permitted.

\*\*Students out of dress code will be written up by the teacher and sent to the office and parents will be called. No student will be allowed to retrieve any dress items from their vehicles during the school day. If students have an "extra" set in their locker they will be allowed to change after the parent is called. The second offense, the student will not be allowed to retrieve items from lockers. Ensure your child comes to school in dress code.

# Any JCMHS student who is attending school off campus such as MOWR or WBL must follow dress code anytime they visit Johnson County Schools during school hours.

#### \*\*Students will not be allowed to go to class out of dress code.

Administrators will have complete and final judgment on all matters concerning the interpretation of the student dress code. Matters concerning appearance and dress not specifically covered shall be at the discretion of the administration.
